Implementation of New Budget Software - Questica



- Rolled out for the CVRD's 2018 2022
 financial planning year in September 2017.
- Provisional FP presented today is in this new reporting format
 - Further reporting refinements pending
 - i.e. Consolidated service report with 5 year financial plan and previous year's budget vs. actuals

- Preliminary FP presented today for discussion
 - Moves to proposed FP with updates based on Board direction and additional information (project carry forward amounts, 2016 surplus carry forwards, further cost refining, etc.)
- CSWM financial plan included in CVRD proposed financial plan and published online in Jan. 2018

CSWM Financial Plan Process



- Proposed CVRD consolidated 2018-2022 FP to be presented to CVRD Board in January 2018
- CSWM Board considers and approves the CSWM service financial plan
 - As per CSWM FP policy Only changes of an administrative nature are made subsequent to the CSWM board approval

- No change to revenue requirements
- Tipping fee stays at \$130/tonne
- Taxation stays at \$4M

No increase to taxes No increase to user fees

Operations:



- Expenses \$228,000 lower than 2017
 - Host community commitments ending
 - Lower wood waste processing costs
 - Lower engineering and professional fees
 - Increased costs for bird control



- Regional Composting
- Stormwater management improvements
- Binwall improvements
- Sayward/Cortez landfill closures
- Vehicle and equipment replacements
- Water supply

Personnel:



- Proposed new positions in 2018:
 - Leachate Treatment plant operator
 - Operations Supervisor Comox Valley
 - Landfill Attendant Comox Valley
- 15.9% increase to salaries and wages
- Impact on benefits and WCB



Debt:



- \$45.3M approved in 2014
- Only \$32.9M projected to complete projects
- \$12.4M in debt savings
 - Lower than expected capital cots
 - Some utilization of operating revenue



Reserve Funds:



- 2016 \$6.9M
- 2022 \$18.1M
- Expected to grow throughout plan
- Potential opportunity to offset debt further

- 391 main solid waste service
- 392 all post closure costs
- 393 all leachate treatment costs

- 2019 \$7M to complete regional organics and final closure of old Comox Valley landfill
- 2020 \$1M for capital equipment plus engineering
- 2021 \$6.3M for Campbell River closure
- 2022 \$2.3M for Campbell River closure
