3	RSW	Rutten	Apr 20,2017	<p>THAT the board refer staff report "CSWM regional organics composting facility approved funding (Project # N20258)" dated April 6, 2017 to all jurisdictions within the CSWM service area;</p> <p>AND FURTHER THAT, in order to enable the regional organics composting facility at Norm Wood Environmental Centre as approved by the New Building Canada Fund – Small Communities Fund grant award, the City of Courtenay and the City of Campbell River confirm commitment to implementing a curbside collection for pre and post-consumer food waste and yard debris (organic feedstocks) and to also consider other points raised in section 9.1.1 of the CS-SWMP;</p> <p>AND FINALLY, that the Town of Comox, City of Courtenay, Village of Cumberland, and City of Campbell River be requested to provide a key staff contact with regards to working with CSWM staff to implement the regional organics composting facility and related programs in 2017.</p>	Letters sent to the municipalities on May 2, 2017	
4	RSW	Rutten	Mar 9,2017	<p>THAT on a non-precedent setting and one time basis, the Comox Valley Regional District enter into an agreement, to include indemnification of the Comox Valley Regional District, with Fireweed Farmstead whereby 260 cubic yards of finished compost from the Comox Valley waste management centre organics composting pilot project be provided at no charge in return for analytical test results from the amended soil and the results of an educational compost comparison garden within one year of receipt of material;</p> <p>AND THAT all pick-up and delivery costs be at the expense of the Fireweed Farmstead.</p>	17May31: Agreement being drafted and scheduled to be finalized by June 30, 2017; Discussions underway. Fireweed has declined for 2017.
