Executive Summary

Since the previous grant status report at July 31, 2021 the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) received notification of approval for the following grant applications:

- Union of BC Municipalities Strengthening communities' services: shelter beds, day programs, and rural outreach (\$1,093,173)
- Investment Agriculture Foundation Comox Valley Agriculture Plan review (\$40,000)
- Ministry of Municipal Affairs Union Bay Water Master Plan (\$50,000)
- Fire Chiefs' Association of BC New equipment Hornby Island (\$13,000)
- Fire Chiefs' Association of BC New equipment Black Creek/Oyster Bay (\$12,600)
- Union of BC Municipalities Spring 2021/2022 C2C Program (\$5,000)
