COMOX VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 693

A bylaw to amend the parks regulations bylaw to include new parks and greenways and to update park regulations.

WHEREAS the Comox Valley Regional District adopted Bylaw No. 103 being the "Electoral Areas Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 103, 2010" on April 27, 2010;

AND WHEREAS the board desires to update the bylaw to add recently acquired, expanded and/or newly named parks, and to update and apply certain parks regulations;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Amendment

- 1. Bylaw No. 103 being "Electoral Areas Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 103, 2010" is hereby amended by:
 - a) Adding the following definitions under Section 2 Interpretation:

"Attractant"	means food or food waste, meat, a carcass or part of a carcass of an animal or fish, compost or any other waste that could attract wildlife
"Wildlife"	means all amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals, both native and not native to the Province, excluding any domesticated animals under the control of a human.

- b) Adding to Section 8 Animals, the following as Section 8(5):
 - (5) No person shall, in any park:
 - (a) feed or attempt to feed wildlife;
 - (b) provide, leave or place an attractant in a manner that attracts or could attract wildlife.
- c) Replacing Sections 11(1) and 11(2) Fires which read as follows:
 - (1) No person shall kindle, build, light, maintain, or use any fire at any location in a park other than a fire in a fire ring or receptacle provided for the purpose at Joe Walker Park or Goose Spit Park by the regional district, and in accordance with regulations in 10(2) below. The prohibition under this section does not include the use of a portable hibachi, barbecue, or propane stove.
 - (2) Fires shall be permitted year round at Joe Walker Park and beach fires shall be permitted at Goose Spit Park between and including May 1st and the first Monday of September only and in accordance with the following:

with the following:

- (1) No person shall kindle, build, light, maintain, or use any fire at any location in a park other than a fire in a fire ring or receptacle provided for the purpose at Joe Walker Park, Royston Seaside Trail or Goose Spit Park by the regional district, and in accordance with regulations in 10(2) below. The prohibition under this section does not include the use of a portable hibachi, barbecue, or propane stove.
 - (2) Fires shall be permitted year round at Joe Walker Park and Royston Seaside Trail. Beach fires shall be permitted at Goose Spit Park between and including May 1st and the first Monday of September only and in accordance with the following:
- d) Replacing Section 14 Garbage, which reads as follows:
 - 14. No person shall deposit, carry or transport into a park any garbage, sewage, refuse, empty or broken bottles, tin cans, cartons, paper, obnoxious material, or other waste of any kind other than in a receptacle provided for that purpose.

with the following:

- 14. (1) No person shall deposit, carry or transport into a park any garbage, sewage, refuse, empty or broken bottles, tin cans, cartons, paper, obnoxious material, or other waste of any kind other than in a receptacle provided for that purpose.
 - (2) No person shall, in any park, deposit or dump any household, business, construction or garden waste, including in any park waste receptacle.
- e) Adding to Section 19 Vehicle control, the following as Section 19(6):
 - 6) No person shall stop or park a vehicle in a space designated for persons with disabilities unless a valid disabled parking permit is visible and legible from outside the vehicle unless the space is signed otherwise.
- Adding the following parks and greenways to Schedule A (Comox Valley Regional District Parks):
 - Railway Grade Connector Trail;
 - Gull Road Greenway;
 - Piercy Park;
 - qax mot Conservation Area;
 - Union Bay Connector Trail.
- g) Adding the following parks and greenways to Schedule B(1) Designated parks for horses:
 - Railway Grade Connector Trail;
 - Gull Road Greenway;
 - qax mot Conservation Area.

h) Adding the following parks and greenways to Schedule B(2) - Dogs Must Be Leashed in Parks:

Park	Months
qax mot Conservation Area	January to December inclusive

i) Replacing the following parks and greenways in Schedule B(2) - Dogs Must Be Leashed in Parks which reads as follows:

Park	Months
Seal Bay Forest and Nature Park (East of Bates Road and Swamp Loop Trail)	January to December inclusive

with the following:

Park	Months
Seal Bay Forest and Nature Park (East of Bates Road, Melda's Marsh Loop and Creek Trail)	January to December inclusive

- j) Adding to Schedule F the park maps for the following parks and greenways:
 - Electoral Area A Piercy Park
 - Electoral Area C qax mot Conservation Area
 - Electoral Area A Railway Grade Connector Trail
 - Electoral Area A Union Bay Connector Trail
 - Electoral Area A Denman Cross Island Trail
 - Electoral Area A Gull Road Greenway
