BYLAW NO. 664

A bylaw to refer to the Master Municipal Construction Documents as a standard for new infrastructure and development for the Union Bay water system

WHEREAS the Union Bay Improvement District adopted "Water Use and Distribution Regular Bylaw, Bylaw No. 226. 2010" on July 21, 2010";

AND WHEREAS Order in Council No. 221 was issued by the Lieutenant Governor in Council on April 6, 2021 ordering the transfer of obligations from the Union Bay Improvement District to the Comox Valley Regional District and the Union Bay Improvement District water service was established as a Comox Valley Regional District service by the conversion effective July 1, 2021;

AND WHEREAS the Comox Valley Regional District Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 226 to include reference to the Master Municipal Construction Documents as a standard for new infrastructure and development for the Union Bay water system;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

Amendment

1) Bylaw No. 226 being "Water Use and Distribution Regular Bylaw, Bylaw #226. 2010" is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Adding Section 10 "System Standards" as follows:

10. System Standards

The Master Municipal Construction Documents (MMCD) are to be used as a standard for consideration of new service connections, applications for service and infrastructure improvements. The Comox Valley Regional District may require any study work or infrastructure improvements to meet MMCD standards.

and renumbering the remaining sections accordingly.

Effective Date

1. This bylaw comes into effect on July 1, 2021.

Citation

2. This Bylaw No. 664 may be cited for all purposes as "Union Bay Water Use and Distribution Regulation Bylaw 226, 2010, Amendment 1".
