OUTCOME: Acknowledgement that, to reduce competition with other core services, federal grant streams were community culture and recreation specific for the first time. The grant program received responses far surpassing funding available. Three local sports organizations in the Valley accessed the COVID local sport funding relief and no similar funding reliefs are being contemplated at this time.
