BYLAW NO. 536

A bylaw to amend the parks regulations bylaw to correct an administrative error

WHEREAS the Comox Valley Regional District adopted Bylaw No. 103 being the “Electoral Areas Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 103, 2010” on April 27, 2010;

AND WHEREAS the board desires to amend the bylaw to correct an administrative error and update the vehicle control regulations;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Amendment

1. Bylaw No. 103 being “Electoral Areas Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 103, 2010” is hereby amended by:

a) Replacing subsection (1) in section 19 “Vehicle control”, which reads:

“The regulations relating to vehicle control are as follows:

- (a) no person shall operate a vehicle, ebike or cycle below the natural boundary or high tide mark in a park, off the designated road ways, or in such a manner as to disturb the natural features of a park;
- (b) no person shall ride any cycle or ebike in a park or on a trail except on public roads or trails designated for such use except authorized personnel patrolling on a cycle or ebike in a park or on a trail;
- (c) no person shall operate or cause to be operated a motorcycle, dirt bike or other motorized vehicle, other than a wheelchair or ebike, on or along a park trail except authorized personnel engaged in the development or maintenance of the park; and
- (d) no person under the age of 16 years shall operate an ebike in a regional district park.”

With the following subsection (1), which reads:

“The regulations relating to vehicle control are as follows:

- (a) no person shall operate a vehicle, ebike or cycle below the natural boundary or high tide mark in a park, off the designated road ways, or in such a manner as to disturb the natural features of a park;
- (b) no person shall ride any cycle or ebike in a park or on a trail except on public roads or trails designated for such use except authorized personnel patrolling on a cycle or ebike in a park or on a trail;
- (c) no person shall operate or cause to be operated a motorcycle, dirt bike or other motorized vehicle, other than a wheelchair or ebike, on or along a park trail
