METRO 2040 VISION

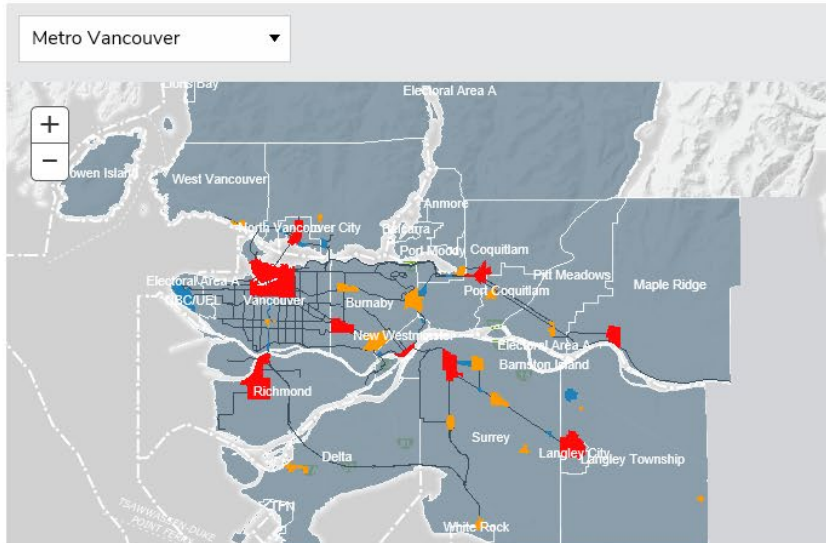
40% of dwelling unit growth is targeted to Urban Centres, 28% is targeted to Frequent Transit Development Areas (FTDAs).



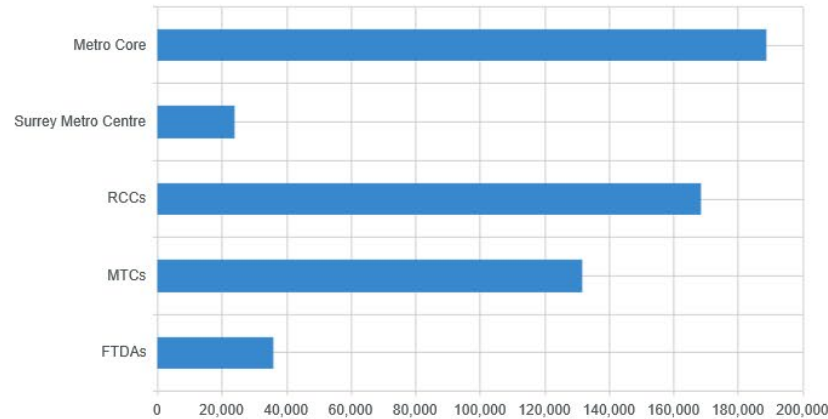
ON TRACK

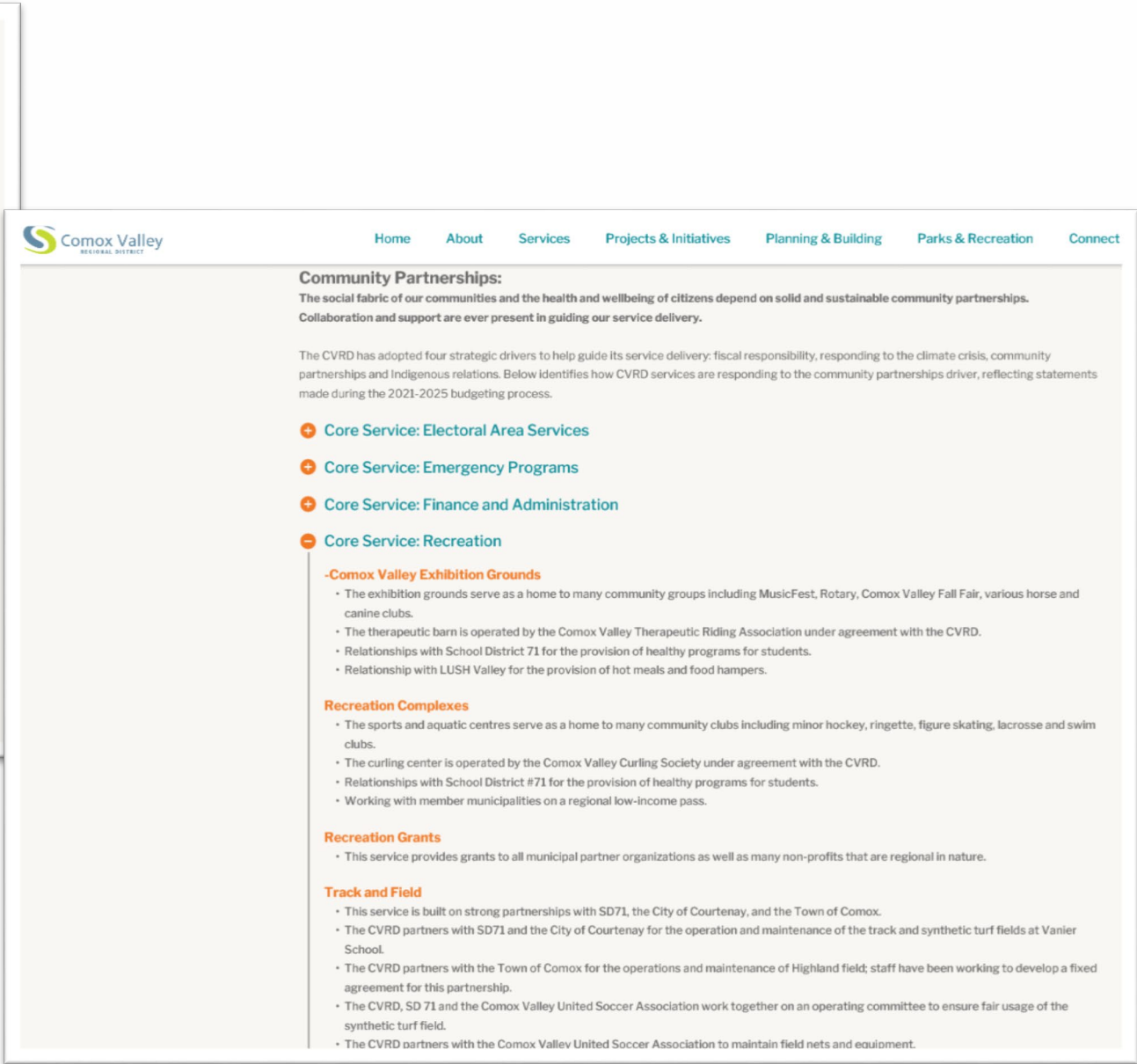
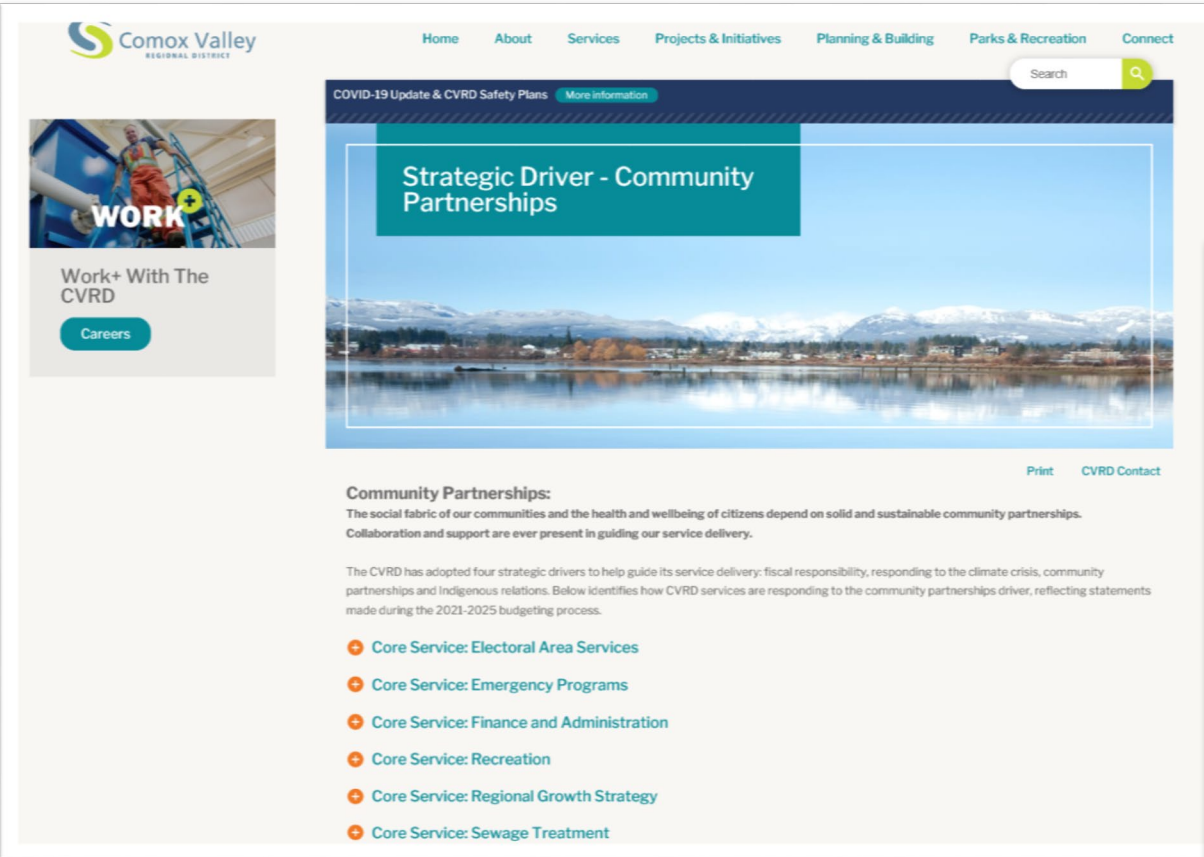


Metro Vancouver 2016 Stats
