## **BYLAW NO. 611**

### A bylaw to amend the municipal ticket information bylaw to update specific fines with respect to Electoral Areas Parks.

**WHEREAS** the *Local Government Act* (RSBC, 2015, c. 1) and the *Community Charter* authorize the Comox Valley Regional District to enact a bylaw to allow the use of ticketing for enforcement offences;

**WHEREAS** the Comox Valley Regional District adopted Bylaw No. 104 being the "Comox Valley Regional District Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 104, 2010" on April 27, 2010;

**WHEREAS** the Comox Valley Regional District adopted Bylaw No. 103 being the "Electoral Areas Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 103, 2010" on April 27, 2010;

AND WHEREAS there is a need to update the fines associated with the violation of specific offenses;

**NOW THEREFORE** the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

### Amendment

- 1) Bylaw No. 104 being "Comox Valley Regional District Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 104, 2010" is hereby amended by:
