## Purpose

The purpose of this staff report is to update the commission on the progress of the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) curling centre renovation project.

## Policy analysis

Staff is committed to keeping the commission informed on the progresses of this capital project including the construction costs associated with it.

At the July 2014 sports centre commission meeting the following motion was passed:

THAT the 2014 – 2018 financial plan and capital expenditure program for Comox Valley recreation complexes function 645 be amended by adding a capital project in the amount of \$1,900,000 in 2014 for building improvements, including architectural and project management services, of the Comox Valley curling centre to be funded by debt financing.

## Executive summary

The curling centre renovation project has moved from the demolition stage into the construction phase. The issues that had presented themselves have been dealt with. Progress can be seen daily with the:

- walkways now in place;
- the header trench has been poured;
- arena floor surface is in the final stages of being prepared for the pouring of the concrete slab, August 5<sup>th</sup>;
- bracing of the structure is being finished up;
- equipment pads are formed with rebar installed ready for concrete;
- the wall panels are on site;
- the refrigeration plant and in slab piping are in the process of being installed,

A rough estimate puts the project completion at the end of October.
