Prior to an Emergency

Obligations in the *Emergency Program Act*Section 6

- (1) responsible for the direction and control
- (2) must prepare or cause to be prepared local emergency plans disasters
- (3) must establish and maintain an emergency management organization
- Support preparedness, response and recovery measures



Activation of an Emergency Operation Centre (EOC)

Chair of the Regional District and Mayors

- play an important role in supporting the EOC and emergency program
- Declarations of a State of Local Emergency, Evacuation Alerts and Evacuation Orders
- may play the lead role in speaking to the media with the support of their response subject matter experts



Activation of an EOC

Chair, Mayors, Electoral Area Directors

 may play the lead role in speaking to the media with the support of their response subject matter experts

Elected Officials – Policy Group (EOC Function)

- overall emergency policy and direction to the EOC Director
- sets expenditure limits
- formalizes requests for outside support / resources (e.g., Provincial and Federal support).
