


Purposes of the COVID-19 EOC

- Driven by actions and announcements from the Province of BC, Island Health, and other external authorities
- Information Officers and CAOs will maintain regular communication with the Policy Groups

Dissemination of factual information and a regional approach to communications is a priority.



Situation Unit Reports

Situation Unit Reports are daily summaries of the happenings on the Event (COVID-19) to the Emergency Operations Centre.

- They typically include Provincial, Federal, and Local announcements, media articles and summaries of the updates provided.
- They also provide an overarching update of communication within EOC.
