ITEMS

Management Report

The management report was reviewed.

BC Transit Corporate Update

BC Transit staff gave an update on staffing and introduced Adrianna McMullen as the new transit planner for the Comox Valley. Various BC Transit staff may attend the Transit Management Advisory Committee meetings depending on subject matter.

BC Transit staff gave a brief review of the draft Annual Performance Summary report and explained that the final report will be circulated to the committee. The committee agreed that the final report should be presented at the Committee of the Whole in September.

BC Transit staff explained that they are still dealing with a few minor issues after the implementation of NextRide and suggested that there needs to be more marketing done.

TMAC Terms of Reference

Russell Dyson, Chief Administrative Officer for the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) attended to review the Terms of Reference with TMAC and thanked the members for providing input. Russell encouraged the members to use all possible opportunities for discussions, not exclusively at the TMAC meetings.

Hospital Bus Stop

CVRD staff reviewed a draft staff report going to the Committee of the Whole in September regarding the bus stop at the new hospital and received input on some wording. CVRD staff explained that there have been no requests for better access to the hospital received.

The committee suggested to present the information currently available to the COW and identified minor changes to the staff report.

August 31st 2018 Service Change Update

BC Transit gave an update on the August 31st scheduled service change and explained that there will be enhanced assistance provided on the ground August 30th and 31st to inform and assist riders. BC Transit staff will be at various bus stops and invited any committee members to attend. BC Transit staff will send M. Zbarsky a schedule.

BC transit staff explained that there will also be meetings with targeted groups to provide training on the new service. A. McMullen will send M. Zbarsky a list of the groups for prioritizing. Trip planning sample sheets will also be distributed to these groups as well as schools, the public and the Watson and Ash answering service.

BC Transit staff explained that the bus stop sign change process is in progress and the new signs need to be in place by August 31st.

Stakeholder Service/Project Updates

The meeting terminated at 11:40 pm.

City of Courtenay staff explained that the roadwork on Cliffe Avenue and 4th Street is about 70% complete.

Town of Comox staff explained that there is now a four way stop at Port Augusta Street and Beaufort Avenue.

Village of Cumberland staff explained that the roadwork project on Egremont Road is still out for tender so there is no known date of the road work yet.
