
- Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program British Columbia Community, Culture and Recreation Infrastructure is accepting grant applications up until October 1, 2020.

- Successful applicants can receive up to 73.33 percent of funding from the Government of Canada/Province of BC.
- The retrofit of the Comox Valley Sports Centre Mezzanine area would be eligible under this grant program and has been identified as a priority for recreation.
