Service Overview

- The CVRD currently manages eleven (11) street lighting services with the oldest established in 1975 (Little River) and the latest in 2010 (Royston).
- Approximately 360 lights owned by BC Hydro and used under agreement for service.
- 8 ornamental lights owned by CVRD in Forest Grove Estates.
- 1 solar light in Royston operational/safety challenges.





Work Plan

2020

- Repairs/maintenance of CVRD owned lights
- Community meetings with Royston residents

2021

- Repairs/maintenance of CVRD owned lights
- Replacement of solar light in Royston, including public notification
- UBID lights
- BC Hydro LED program?





BC Hydro LED program


- Replacing all of their lights with LED over the next 2-3 years. Timing for Comox Valley currently unknown.
- Compliance with new federal regulations that require all light ballasts containing Poly-Chlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) be removed
- The new LED fixtures also help reduce light pollution and energy use, last longer and require less maintenance.
- BC Hydro will incur considerable costs to convert existing lights to LEDs.
 These costs are being recovered through a new increased rate which took effect December 2020 and is incorporated into the CVRD's street lighting budgets.
