## **Executive Summary**

- The Comox Valley Regional District completed a review of all its grant funding programs and services in 2020 in an effort to standardize processes, establish more formalized criteria and to ensure increased transparency and clarity to both the public and to any non-profit organizations seeking or receiving funding.
- In August 2020 a rebranding of the now former Grant in Aid program as the Rural Community Grant (RCG) program was approved;

## Staff Report - 2021 Rural Community Grant Considerations

- The program included moving towards election cycle multi-year agreements for some traditionally long-standing grant-in-aid recipients, which is expected to be in place this fall dependent on the recommendations of this report.
- The RCG program was launched in January 2021; any non-profit community organization may apply for funding that benefits the general community.
- Applications to the RCG program will continue to be considered on a year-to-year basis for any organization not supported under the multi-year agreement stream, and therefore ongoing funding support should not be anticipated.
- RCG applicants will receive written notice on the status of their funding request once the ٠ Elector Area Directors have met and completed their adjudication and funding allocation.
- Funding awards will be dispersed after August 1, 2021, unless otherwise stipulated. ٠
- Electoral Areas Services Committee members are asked to review the attached listing of submissions and advise of their funding commitment.
