Re: Renata King, N.D.I.T. conversation with Russell Dyson, CVRD.

"She assured me that if the CVRD were to be involved it would only be as the applicant on behalf of the island groups and we would be responsible for administering any funds granted for the feasibility study. She assured me this would be the extent of CVRD involvement and we would not be owning, operating or anything long term. The CVRD as the applicant and administrator of grant funding would not necessarily cost the communities anything so long as you would be able to do the heavy lifting. We may need to oversee any contract awards to ensure there is a competitive process. we would need to secure a resolution of our Board, that should be factored in the timeline to get the application submitted."
