Thank you for the notice of this upcoming event and the opportunity to provide feedback. As neighbours to this event we have some concerns – mostly about noise:

- 1. A four day event (7 days in total) with 600 participants/vendors/volunteers and the required services will be a disruption to our rural residential neighbourhood.
- 2. We are concerned about the volume of the live music and how many of the 4-7 days it will be played.
- 3. In the past, this property has been the location for other very loud and late events we are concerned that this event will turn into another very unpleasant long weekend at our home.
- 4. We are concerned with a precedent being set with these events as acceptance to one event can lead to more. One event, if proven to be reasonably quiet and non-disruptive to our lives may be acceptable.

Overall, we were satisfied with how this event was run last year by Jeepaplooza and impressed by their fundraising success. We would prefer if the event were for less days and the noise (music +?) was limited in volume, lateness and number of days (1?).
