- Proposed 2019 tax requisition \$540,000.
- Total operating costs of \$239,922 in 2019
- Capital replacement of rescue truck in 2019, \$25,000
- Construction of training facility in 2019.
- Contribution to capital reserve of \$97,400 in 2019
- Capital reserve balance \$121,850 at end of 2019

- 2018 Achievements
 - 2 rookies graduated to "firefighter"
 - Superior Shuttle Service Accreditation
 - Saved 2/3 of community school from fire
- 2018 Calls/Stats
 - 163 calls in 2018, 66% medical calls
- 2019 Work plan priorities
 - Develop training facility.
 - Graduate 4 rookies to firefighter.
 - Complete landscaping at fire hall.
