What is Multi-Modal Transportation?

 Allows people to travel using several forms of transportation, often in a single trip.

Example: A person might load their bike onto a bus, ride, then hop onto a ferry and then pedal to a final destination.

 Multi-modal transportation might include a combination of shared transportation—e.g., a bus—and personal transportation, such as a private car or bicycle.



What is Active Transportation?

Types of Active Transportation

- Walking, including jogging, walking dogs etc.
- Bicycling
- Rolling (skateboarding, longboarding, scootering, rollerblading)
- **Sliding** (cross-country skiing, skating etc)
- Gliding (canoe, kayak, stand-up paddleboard etc.)
- Horseback riding
- Micro-mobility (e-bike, e-scooters, etc.)




What is Regional Transportation?
