RE: CSRHD and Island Health Liaison Meetings Update

Purpose

To update the Comox Strathcona Regional Hospital District (CSRHD) Board on recent CSRHD and Island Health liaison meetings held May 14 and June 25, 2021.

Executive Summary

At its April 1, 2021 meeting, the CSRHD Board adopted a resolution to enable the Chair and Vice-chair to meet with Island Health a few times each year to advance the following:

- Advocate: To influence the Provincial Government and Island Health to advance the CSRHD's strategic interests and ambitions and to foster broad support for the improvement of healthcare facilities within the region;
- Cooperate: To seek opportunities and arrangements to build and nurture a positive working relationship with Island Health through meaningful dialogue and the identification and pursuit of mutually beneficial projects and initiatives;
- Inform: To work to clarify roles, identify and promote ways the public can engage with Island Health, to inform both the public and Island Health, and to establish an effective two-way communications vehicle between CSRHD and Island Health; and
- Engage: To explore and address identified issues or interests of the CSRHD concerning
 operational healthcare services or other matters outside of the traditional mandate of the
 CSRHD.

This report provides a brief update on topics discussed from meetings held May 14 and June 25, 2021. A third meeting was scheduled for October 13, 2021 and will be reported on at a subsequent CSRHD meeting.

Attendees at each of the May and June meetings included Chair Cornfield and Vice-chair Hillian, Deputy CAO James Warren and Island Health representatives James Hansn, Scott McCarten and Max Jajszczok.

May 14 discussion

- Initial liaison meeting that set terms for discussions, and emphasized using the liaison meetings as a venue for operational aspects and clarifying community information; topics for future meetings to be generated by both CSRHD Chair/Vice-chair and Island Health
- Laboratory operational topics are with Island Health, and if needed discussions can be held during liaison meetings; CSRHD Board meetings to focus on capital priorities
- Community information sharing may best be undertaken in partnership with community health networks

June 25 discussion

Officer

- Topics included
 - o ongoing priority for developing community based congregate care such as long term care to relieve pressures on acute care facilities,
 - o community benefits that can be realized in dedicated facilities that co-locate activities such as home care, ambulatory, recreation and social services
 - o other Island Health initiatives including at Nanaimo, North Island pathology demands and repatriating some activities back to geography 1.
